Principal's Message - Mr. Jeremy Brunner

Welcome to another great year at Foothill Elementary! I am so grateful for the opportunity I have to be the principal here and look forward to working with you and your child this year!

Student safety is our number one priority, but we need your help! Please support our student safety efforts by remembering these important things: 1) Be safe in the drop off zones. Do not park your vehicle in a red curb zone, and only let your children in and out of your vehicle by using your vehicle's doors that are closest to the curb. Only allow your children to cross the drop-off zone by using the crosswalk. Drive slowly and never use your phone while in the pick up zones.

2) Sign in at the office whenever your visit the school during the school day. Aside from the front main doors of the school, the exterior doors to the building are locked once school gets going and so please use the front middle doors. Even if you are just running in for a moment, we need you to sign in at the front office.

3) Teach your child about what to do after school. If your child rides the bus, encourage him or her to hurry to the bus after school each day. If your child gets picked up from school, teach him or her to come to the office on days when rides are running late. If your child walks to get home, teach him or her about staying with a group of friends and about stranger danger.

The teachers and staff at Foothill do a great job of providing a safe and nurturing environment. With your help, this will be another great year!



Welcome back parents and students! I hope you all had a wonderful summer! Here are a few health reminders for our upcoming school year.

1. If your student has a health condition requiring care or possible care at school, please notify me or your student's teacher. I will need to have you complete a health care plan that will be kept on file at school so we know what to do to keep your child safe at school. These health care plans are available in the office.

2. If your student wears glasses or contact lenses, please make sure those are being worn at school. Please note on the school calendar when the vision screening will be and make sure your students have their glasses/contact lenses on that day.

3. We had a very high absence rate due to illnesses last year. PLEASE KEEP YOUR STUDENTS HOME FROM SCHOOL WITH THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS OR CONDITIONS:

-COLDS, FLU

-DIARRHEAL DISEASES

-IMPETIGO- MUST BE TREATED WITH ANTIBIOTIC FOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS BEFORE THE CHILD MAY RETURN TO SCHOOL.

-PINK EYE OR CONJUNCTIVITIS- MUST BE TREATED WITH ANTIBIOTIC FOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS BEFORE THE CHILD MAY RETURN TO SCHOOL.

-ANY OPEN WOUND OR SORE

-PERSISTENT COUGH

-NAUSEA OR VOMITING

-STREP THROAT OR OTHER BACTERIAL INFECTION- MUST BE TREATED WITH ANTIBIOTIC FOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS BEFORE THE CHILD MAY RETURN TO SCHOOL. -FEVER 100.5 DEGREES OR ABOVE -PRESENCE OF ANY SKIN RASHES THAT MAY BE DUE TO AN INFECTION E.G. MEASLES, STREP, STAPH, FUNGUS, CHICKENPOX -FOUL SMELLING URINE OR BLOOD IN URINE

-EARACHE OR EAR DRAINAGE

THIS POLICY IS IMPLEMENTED AND REVIEWED YEARLY BY UTAH COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT MEDICAL DIRECTORS.

4. PLEASE ENCOURAGE GOOD HANDWASHING HABITS AT HOME. REMIND YOUR STUDENTS TO WASH THEIR HANDS AT SCHOOL. HANDWASHING REMAINS OUR #1 DEFENSE AGAINST DISEASE TRANSMISSION.

5. PLEASE HAVE YOUR FAMILIES GET FLU SHOTS IF POSSIBLE! ALTHOUGH WE KNOW THAT THE FLU VACCINE IS NOT 100% EFFECTIVE, IT IS MORE HELPFUL WHEN LARGER NUMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY ARE IMMUNIZED!





Do I have to cut out the box top perfectly from each package?

NO!!! Just rip it off the fastest way. As long as the Expiration Date and 4 Letter Code are intact, it counts!

EXAMPLES THAT WORK: 4 Letter Code is intact and Expiration Date is intact & has not expired. THESE <u>DO NOT</u> WORK: 4 Letter Code is cut off &/or Box Top has expired or expiration date is missing.

• Do I have to use the collection sheets that are sent home? NO!!! Put all your Box Tops in a baggie or envelope and include your child and teacher names on it.

• My child didn't receive his/her prize. Why?

Each month there are many collection sheets returned without a name on them. Please make sure to put your child's name on each collection sheet or baggie/envelope that is returned. Otherwise, we have no way of knowing whose it is and who should get the prize.
