The Reading Contest has begun! This contest is designed to improve reading ability and to promote a life-long love of reading. We want students to not only read more each day, but to also explore different kinds of books. Maybe your child can discover a new favorite story!

From Monday March 2nd through Friday, March 13th, we want to encourage our students to read for extra minutes when they aren't in school! *Enter your child's minutes into a form on the school's website each day to make him or her eligible to win prizes* (Minutes can be submitted in 20 minute increments with a maximum of 300 minutes per day). A reminder email with the link for submitting minutes will be sent out nightly.

Reading that counts: Books, magazines, comic books, Lexia practice, Starfall, etc.

Reading that **doesn't** count: Closed captioning on a TV screen, road signs, audiobooks, reading during school hours, etc.
