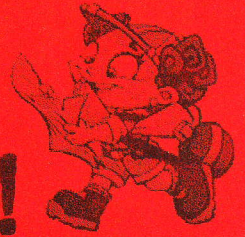




Forbes Research Challenge 2015

Are you curious? Do you have questions you want answers to? Did you ever wonder how something was made? Do you have an idea for an invention? Do you just want to know more about something?

How do I get involved in the Research Challenge?

- Pick a topic or ask a question you would like to investigate further.
- Research may be done individually, or by small groups of students working as a research team.
- Fill in the entry form.
- Hand your entry form to your teacher.
- Start your research, investigate your question, collect your data and information, and create your research presentation.
- Research may be presented in any format you choose such as: audio report, video report, magazine article, written report, research poster (either on-line or on a presentation board,) Power Point presentation, game, an on-line book or a physical/paper book, or some other creative presentation media. Anything created on the internet is downloaded to your computer. Alpine School District blocks a lot of sites, so what works at home may not work at school.
- **Resources:**
 - Content Experts (Identify people in the community who are experts in your area of research and contact them about questions you have.)
 - Library and Internet (Use the local and school library. Try a Google search!)
 - Parents and Family (Your parents and family can be excellent sources of information for you. You should talk to them about your research topic and get their ideas of where to go for information.)
 - Faculty (Teachers can also help you with information and direct you to other sources of information.)
- Pay attention to the deadlines, and prepare to present your final presentation at the **Research Recital**.
