#### Trustlands 2014-15

\$46,700 spent allotted, 43 percent of funds spent to date, on target for expenditures.  
personnel is majority of funding-aides working in Booster club and in classrooms  
substitutes for DRA & Mastery Connect

Committee reviewed the school's stakeholder report and other data  
Goals 2014-15 were on DRA, School Writing and proficiency rates for SAGE in LA and Math.

DRA Benchmark Percentage for 2014-15:

62% at Benchmark Fall 2014

83% at Benchmark Winter 2015

This is already an improvement from 81% proficiency in Spring 2014.

#### Trustlands 2015-16

Grant proposal due April 3, 2015, approval of grant will be an action item for next meeting. All CC members should attend.

Area of most critical need continues to be Language Arts with an emphasis on meeting benchmark levels for reading and writing. Math has been an area of focus, and will continue as a need. Committee was asked to discuss and evaluate needs for next year.

These include:

Summer Collaborative Grants, anticipating up to four teams through Trustlands.

Emphasis on student interventions through Booster Club, Den Time, and Classroom Aides.

Continue with schoolwide writing rubric

Continue funding of Mastery Connect to track student progress and interventions.
