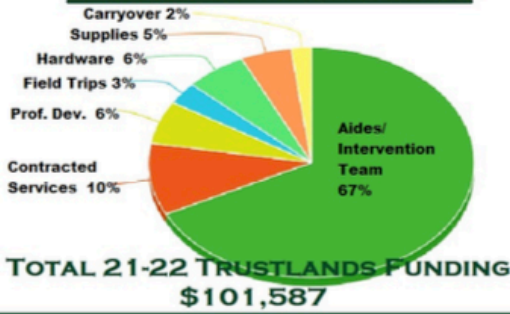
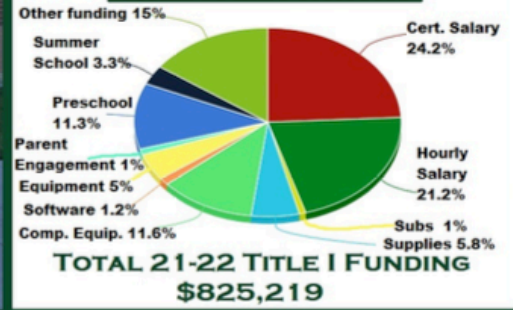

School-Wide Achievement Goal: Students at Mount Mahogany Elementary will increase their proficiency by 4% from fall 2022 to spring 2023 in Language Arts as measured by the Acadience reading assessments as compared to the previous year's proficiency for that group of students.

School Connection Goal: All employees at Mount Mahogany Elementary will have a positive daily connection with students. All employees will connect with families and the community.

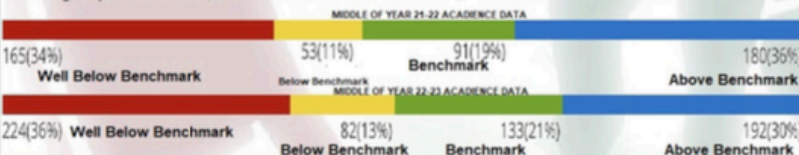
