# **Teacher Appreciation Week**




Room Moms,

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# Education in State Legislature

There are many educational issues being discussed in the State Legislature this year. Here are the issues pertaining to education:

- \* Charter School Funding
- \* Early College High Schools/Graduation Requirements
- \* Optional Full-Day Kindergarten
- \* End of Level Testing
- \* School Partnerships/Inter-generational Poverty
- \* Firearm Safety Education for Students

I encourage you to let your legislator know of your concerns. Here's how:

Go to <a href="http://le.utah.gov/">http://le.utah.gov/</a>. At the lower left corner of the screen click on the link that says, "Who represents me?" (or, if you are on a handheld device, "find my representatives" at lower center). By submitting your address and zip code, you will find the names of your senator and representative. Click on these to find their email and other contact information. Save this information.

Please resolve to contact both your Senator and Representative often during the session. Here are some do's and don'ts about writing to your legislators.

DO be respectful. "Dear Senator (last name)" or "Dear Representative (last name)".

DO let them know you are a voter in their district. If you are a delegate for their political party, note that too.

DO be concise. State in a short sentence why they should support your position. Example: "Research shows that Optional Extended-day Kindergarten is the most cost-efficient way to help at-risk children. Please vote for (bill number and name)." Long explanations are neither necessary nor helpful.

DO be gracious. End with something like: "Thank you for your service."

DON'T apologize. Assume they want to hear from you. They should!

A short email is easy and has a BIG impact. Many short emails make an even bigger impact so encourage friends to do the same.

Let your voice be heard!
