



During the 2021-2022 school year, students from grades 3-6 at North Point Elementary will have the opportunity to participate in Battle of the Books, a voluntary reading incentive program that encourages careful reading of quality books in a variety of genres. Students read specific books throughout the year and compete as teams in quiz-show style battles in the spring.

BOB is a national program (http://www.battleofthebooks.org/) in which the Alpine School District actively participates. The district encourages its schools to participate as well, including inviting winning 5th/6th grade teams to represent their schools at a district championship each year.
