- I will tell a trusted adult if anything makes me feel uncomfortable or confused.
- 3- I will keep my personal information and passwords personal. I will only share them with a parent.
- 4- I will use technology to connect my real-life friends, NOT to meet strangers. People online are not always who they say they are.

We will also have different activities to help the children understand the importance of positive media choices. More information will be sent out next week.

STORYTELLING FESTIVAL

This year the students of Orem Elementary will once again have the opportunity to participate in the Storytelling Festival. This is a chance for any student in Kindergarten-6th grade to participate in sharing a story. If your child would like to participate, he/she can sign up in class between February 4th and February 15th.

The student will first need to find a story, preferably one that isn't as well known. A published book, an original story or even a true experience can be used. The student should then memorize it and practice, practice, practice!

Students will be presenting their stories in their classroom on Wednesday, February 20th. There will be judges in each class. A finalist from each grade will be chosen and will then tell their stories in an assembly for the school to be held on Monday, February 25th.

From these finalists, two over-all school winners will also be chosen — one for the lower grades (Kindergarten-3rd) and one for the upper grades (4th-6th grade). These two students will go to the District Storytelling Festival for a chance to participate in the Timpanogos Storytelling Festival.
