

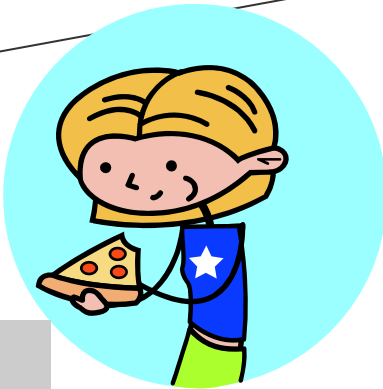


# CARNIVAL... About a week! YIPPEE!!
