

## **PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE**

Parents,

With the support of our PTA, we are making a big push on reading this year.

Reading, and a love for reading, begins at home. Give your child lots of opportunities to read aloud. Inspire your young reader to practice every day!

Here are a couple of suggestions that we hope you find useful in helping your child in becoming an independent, fluent reader:

- The most important thing you can do for your reader is to read to them. Read things that he/she are interested in and things for just pure enjoyment.
- Also having your child read to a younger child, parent or stuffed animal can help him or her achieve the fluency needed to develop good comprehension. This also encourages reading "for a purpose," and can help readers understand that they must read so that it can be understood by their listening audience.
- Another suggestion to develop great readers in your home is to never leave home without a book. Anytime there is wait time in the car or at the doctors office is a great time to fit in reading.
- Also finally, encourage your child to re-read favorite books and poems. Re-reading helps kids read more quickly and accurately. Our goal at Ridgeline is for our students to have a love for reading.
