- 1. Call to order Laura Harris 9.40am

- 3. Minutes from May Julie Matern . Motion to approve. Minutes stand approved.
- 4. Treasurer's report Wendy Condie
  - i) Budget -

Proposed budget - tightened this year. See year end financial statement. Year financial review needs to be approved also. Approve at end of meeting so that everyone can see if before approval. Mary Thomas question - \$4000 for fundraising? Wendycost of year books, net \$1000. Laura Harris – cuts made to be more responsible in spending. Will be asked to justify any receipt you submit for expenses this year. Any money that you want to spend needs to be pre-approved. Unapproved expenses will not be reimbursed.

Procedure for reimbursement: a) Obtain a check request form from PTA box in teacher's lounge. b) Itemize receipt. Have to submit tax. Don't add personal items to any PTA receipt. c) Fill out purpose and why you spent it. Need to be transparent in our spending.

Can amend budget but has to be BEFORE money spent.

Other budget questions:

Heather – lunch with Dr Higgins. Not on there? Kept as silent auction. Wasn't listed as an expense. Need to amend that to \$100. Change on budget to 'Lunch with Principal.'

Laura - We took out teacher gift- need to put it back as separate line item. Keep as \$75. Teacher appreciation – do we want to scale this back? Mrs Gardner – do you like the craft/treat every day? Treats preferred. Is \$800 all for gifts for teachers, shouldn't that money be used for school – Mary. Alicia seconds that. Parents do things on their own for teacher. Laura – that's why it nearer end of school. Can we do it for less? Explanation of teacher appreciation for new member. One gift for the week.

Proposal to reduce budget to \$400 for teacher appreciation.

Motion to approve budget by Laura Harris. Seconded by Kari Tuttle. Motion approved at 11.05am.

- 7. <u>Membership VP</u> Julie Brinkerhoff membership drive at Open House 274. (last year only 117) Will push it as Parent/teacher conf. Council has asked us to boost. We can win awards.
- 8. Teacher rep Brittiney Gardner nothing yet
- 9. Principal's report Dr Higgins
- i) New school grading system. Most principals and teachers orgs are not liking new grading system. 4% of Utah schools got a failing grade mostly HS and alternative schools. Some big schools failed because participation too low. Ridgeline came out as B grade. We can do better. 11% of state got A, 45% B's. We do great with proficiency: 89% science, 91% LA, 91% math. We are hurt on improvement. All kids need to grow and maintain. Gone from 3% Special ed 11%. They go in the mix. Harder for them to improve. Economics plays a part: went from 3% 13% free lunch. Big factor. Put emphasis on lower grades every K has aide will pay good dividends. Optional extended day for K continued this year for targeted kids. RAZ kids grant money computer based. Reading Horizons new phonics based program. Teachers being trained and parents welcome to training.
- ii) 10 extra kids since beginning of school. But class size is great. 31 is highest. Average 25. Got funding right after school started for new 2<sup>nd</sup> grade teacher and new resource teacher.
- iii) \*\*Remember Smith's bar code. Got \$5800 last year. Lot of freedom with money. Promote it.
- iv) New computer lab from grant and 40 Ipads and 3 new kindles.
- v) New neighborhoods 170 homes going in. Will impact school Within 3 months Julie Brinkerhoff asked Will they build new school? Will they re-align boundaries? Dr Higgins doesn't anticipate that. 4000 homes by Micron in our boundary. District decision.

Question: Do you work with school photographer? We help you stream the photos in. School in control of how look. Parents like hardcovers, will pay whatever for it.
