School Updates:

Updated 2017-2018 approval of teachers:

- 5 teachers in each grade (1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>)

Rocky Reading - Amy Peterson, Veronica Reginato, Miquelin Smith, Michelle Beckstead, Mary Thomas and Elizabeth Sweat did an excellent job. Teachers helped to make the program a success. Many teachers held their own drawings and had their own incentives for students.

BOB - Deb McKinzie made this wonderful. So many students participated this year!

SAGE - begins March 20<sup>th</sup> for writing. All other subjects open after spring break. April 10 or 11.

Bench Mark testing could be implemented next year. 5<sup>th</sup> grade piloted it this year, and it worked well. Teachers are able to view the questions and see what students struggled with.

DIBELS - testing has been going well. Final test will be given in May. Results are available to the teacher the day of the test.

Music - parents enjoyed the class music recitals that Andrea Morley implemented this year and would like for this to continue each year.

Class Donations - teachers may request class supplies. Parents are allowed to donate, should they choose to do so.

Trust Lands – last year we were given \$65,000. This year the amount was raised to \$88,000. The goal of Trust Lands is to improve reading scores by 2% in the lower grades and to improve math scores 2% in the upper grades.

Proposed Trust Lands expenditures:

- Trackers - help students with DIBELS, math, and reading
- Double Dose - hoping for grant toward Double Dose
- Technology – the additional devises will be for first/second grade. Currently investigating different options with loaners from the district.
- LCD projectors and sound systems on the stage and in classrooms that are in need of updating. Any carryover from the 2016-2017 Trust Lands could begin replacing worn out systems and added technology
