• 2013 – 2014 Goal possibilities

Goals made last year were based on proficiency scores on the CRT. Dave Smith (district data specialist) suggests that we base our goals on growth scores. 45 and higher means there was significant growth. $2011-4^{th}$ grade median was 58, 5^{th} was 63, 6^{th} 54. $2012-4^{th}$ 48, 5^{th} was 63, 6^{th} was 57.

We need to determine what a reasonable goal is. There are many changed with new core, new tests, new principal, etc.

Literacy goal for 4th-6th: maintain a Student Growth Percent of 45 or higher.

Literacy goal for K-3: at least 75% pass DRA.

Erin- are they going to knock us down because we didn't raise the goals from last year.

Peggy - no, they understand this is going on.
