PTA Survey Results

Here are the results from the last month's PTA survey, based on 85 responses:

1. Are you a member of PTA? 55. 3% yes 44. 7% no

2. We have noticed a drop in volunteers this year. Do you volunteer? 58. 8% yes 23. 5% no, I don't have time, 3. 5% no, I don't want to 2. 4% no, not interested in any of the programs, 3. 5% no, I don't know how to get involved, 8. 2% none of these

We have discussed some things we can do to get information to parents so those that want to be involved can. We are sorry that we have not done better to communicate how to get involved.

3. We have several parents willing to run a <u>Battle of the Books</u> and Knowledge Bowl in place of our PTA reading, social studies and math programs. Would you support that change? 47. 1% Maybe, I would like more information about the programs, 34. 1% Yes, 7. 1% Yes, I would like to help, 3. 5% no, 1. 2% no, not interested

Heidi Spann is one of the parents willing to run the Battle of the Books. She helped run it at Highland Elementary and will explain how it will work for all the grades at the school.

4. PTA does one big fundraiser in the spring, the Walk A Thon. <u>Would you support a flat donation of \$15 per student</u> (For example, if you have 2 students you would donate \$30) instead of the Walk A Thon?

71. 8% yes 27. 1% no 1. 2% none of these

We will implement this as our fundraiser the coming school year 2017-2018. This way the flat donation can be made over time if you have multiple children. We will have a deadline so we can know if we need to have the Walk A Thon in the Spring. This year's Walk A Thon is already in development or we might have tried to do the flat donation this year.

5. If we went to a flat donation, and we didn't raise enough to support the current PTA programs we would need to cut programs or do another fundraiser. Which would you support?

61. 2% I support another fundraiser 29. 4 % I support cutting programs 9. 4% None of these

6. If we needed to cut programs which should we consider?

I included the amounts PTA spends on the programs. Another option would be to cut the budgets down for each program or cut some out completely.

7. We would like to make you aware of things going on at the school. <u>Which is your preferred method of communication?</u>

85. 9% email, 11. 8% automated call with announcements, 2. 4% social media
